- B. Report Discussion –

## Mining Update

- i. Mining activities continued in Open Cut 1 with some material being dumped in Open Cut 2.
- ii. Spontaneous combustion management continued.
- iii. 347,875 tonnes of coal were mined, and 1.99 million cubic metres of waste was removed during the reporting period.
- iv. 197 hours was lost due to rain. 2 hours lost due to adverse weather conditions and impacts on dust generation. 3 hours lost to fog.

## West Muswellbrook Project

• There will be a drilling program at West Muswellbrook during 2020/2021. The review is looking at t underground mining operation so more data is required.

## Weather

- i. *Windroses:* Primarily strong south easterly wind directions for September and October and north westerly winds for November.
- ii. *Rain:* Low rainfall for this period. Below average for August, October and November and slightly above average for September.

#### Dust

i.  $PM_{10}$ : All sites below yearly criteria. High results in recent months attributable to regional dust events or smoke haze from bushfires.

## **Gas Monitoring**

i. Gas monitor results from Muscle Creek, were presented to the CCC. All results were below criteria. Full results are available on the company website.

# Water

i. The ongoing dry conditions are affecting the water quality results. Electrical conductivity is increasing, and pH is increasing at one site due to presence of algae in the water.

Hamish McTaggart asked about why there is no water quality data from the underground workings since May 2019. Julie Thomas responded that the pump from this bore has not been operational in this time. Actions have been put in place to collect samples in the future from the underground workings.

## **Blasting**

i. Blast monitoring results up until October 2019 were presented and were compliant with the blasting criteria.

ii. Noise monitoring results up until November 2019 were presented and were compliant with the noise criteria.
