- i. Windroses: Primarily strong south easterly wind directions for January to April and north westerly winds for May.

Answer: Grant Clouten advised that yes, the time of year is taken into consideration however currently MCC is mining in a very difficult area. This area that was expected to take two (2) months however this has extended to four (4) months due to the challenging work area.

Grant Clouten provided the CCC members with an update on the proposed Pumped Hydro facility. Idemitsu Australia Resources has entered into an arrangement with AGL to conduct a feasibility study which is expected to take approximately 18 months. Whilst Grant is not involved in this process as it is being over seen by MCC's Corporate office in Brisbane Grant will continue to provide quarterly updates.
