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1. Executive Summary

No exploration activities were conducted in the reporting period in accordance with the Forward Works Program.

The Community Consultative Committee (CCC) meetings were the principal forum for communicating exploration activities on ML1883 during the reporting period with meetings held in November 2024 and February, May and September 2025.

The Aboriginal Stakeholder Consultative Forum (ASFC) meetings were the principal forum for communicating exploration activities on ML1883 during the reporting period to the Registered Aboriginal Parties, with a meeting held in March 2025.

No issues have been raised with Boggabri Coal Mine (BCM) in relation to ML1883 exploration during the reporting period.

BCM received no complaints in relation to ML1883 exploration during the reporting period.

2. Consultation completed in reporting period

BCM operates a CCC that meets on a quarterly basis. The purpose of this committee is to inform the community, via committee members, of all aspects of BCM's activities, including activities in ML1883. Boggabri Coal informs its Registered Aboriginal Parties and other Indigenous stakeholders via the Aboriginal Stakeholder Consultative Forum that meets throughout the year.

The CCC meetings were the principal forum for communicating exploration activities on ML1883 during the reporting period with meetings held in November 2024 and February, May and September 2025. Exploration was specifically included in these meeting to inform the community of any exploration activity.

3. Outcomes of consultation

No issues have been raised with BCM in relation to ML1883 exploration during the reporting period.
BCM received no complaints in relation to ML1883 exploration during the reporting period.

4. Proposed future consultation

BCM will continue to operate a CCC that meets on a quarterly basis.

BCM will continue to conduct Aboriginal Stakeholder Consultative Forum meetings throughout the coming reporting period.
