



Relevant criteria	Consideration
Soil slope and contiguous land	The site comprises soil landscapes that fail to meet the criteria for biophysical strategic agricultural land (BSAL) due to a combination of physical constraints. A majority (264 hectares) of the study area comprises soil slopes exceeding 10% and the remaining fragmented areas are less than 20 contiguous hectares.
Soil fertility and effective rooting depth	The remaining 146 hectares are made up of 2 soil types (Maules Gravelly Sands and Maules Gravelly Gradational Clays) that did not meet soil fertility and/or effective rooting depth criteria. The Department's Soil and Landscape Assessment Team agreed that the area was not likely to contain BSAL and that the soil mapping completed by the applicant was consistent with the Department's soil landscape mapping and that the shallow soils precluded there being BSAL present.
